IRU congratulates Professor Barney Glover AO on appointment as Jobs and Skills Australia Commissioner

The Innovative Research Universities (IRU) congratulates Professor Barney Glover AO on his appointment as the new Commissioner of Jobs and Skills Australia (JSA).

Professor Glover has played a significant leadership role within the IRU and the Australian higher education sector. He has served as Chair of the IRU in 2013 and also as Chair of Universities Australia.
